## Our initiatives include

- Part time teachers allocated specific subject areas to focus on that are within their own areas of interest and expertise.
- The school providing individually tailored professional development and resources to build the capacity of teachers within those specific teaching areas.
- Ensuring Principal has dedicated non-contact time each week to focus on data collection, collation and review.
- Ensuring regular time is allocated to working with staff to strengthen their own use of data to inform student learning.
